We remember with LOVE—Mr. Frank Frame



C. Frank Frame, 84, retired superintendent of Scotland School for Veterans' Children, passed away on January 22, 2025 at his home in Chambersburg, PA surrounded by his loving family following a sixteen-year battle with Parkinson's disease.

Born in 1940 in Charleston, WV, to the late Ralph A. Frame, Sr., and Thelma Humphreys Frame, Frank graduated from Stonewall Jackson High in 1958. He received a B.S. in Secondary Education from West Virginia University in 1963 and an M.Ed. in Earth Science from The Pennsylvania State University in 1970. Additionally, he earned certifications in Curriculum and Instruction and as a Secondary Principal from McDaniel College (formerly Western Maryland College) and an Elementary Principal and Letter of Eligibility for Superintendency from Shippensburg University. A lifelong learner, he continued to fuel his curiosity for education, leadership and history throughout this life.

Frank met and married Loretta Palmer in their first teaching assignment in Berlin, MD in 1965. They moved to Ft. Myers, FL where they were blessed with the birth of their son Sean, remaining there for two years before moving to Shippensburg, PA in 1967 when he began working for Scotland School for Veterans' Children.

Mr. Frame, as he was known at school, remained at SSSC for thirty-two years, retiring in 1999. During his tenure he served as teacher, coach, curriculum coordinator, principal, assistant superintendent, and superintendent. Known by his students as a true servant leader, Frank was a man who led by example through outstanding leadership, fostered student academic and personal development through trust, enhancing relationships, and encouraging all of his students to do great things. His impact on the lives of his many students reaches far and wide as he had a very special way of loving people through listening and encouraging them, offering wise counsel and genuine care.

While on sabbatical in 1990-1991 traveling across the US to observe best practices in residential education settings, the Frames received the call that the governor had announced the closure of the school. They immediately came back to Pennsylvania where he sprang into action to align supporters in the veterans' community and the state legislature to keep SSSC open. Although he was told it "simply couldn't be done," through his efforts and those of his team, they were able to keep the school open for nearly twenty more years. For these stalwart efforts he was the first civilian inducted in the Pennsylvania Military and Veterans' Affairs Hall of Fame as well as given many citations and awards by veterans' service organizations at the local and state level.

Following Mr. Frame's retirement as superintendent in 1999, he was employed for four years as general manager of the Chambersburg Country Club where he enjoyed working with members and staff alike. He also stayed involved with the Foundation for SSSC, an organization he founded in 1996, raising more than \$2M to enhance education and student quality of life on campus. He was its executive director in 2010 until the organization's closure in 2012. He also served a six-year term on the board of the Chambersburg Area Education Foundation.

Frank belonged to multiple professional organizations and received numerous awards, recognitions, and accolades associated with his profession. He also served as a founding member of the Coalition for Residential Education, the international organization for residential excellence. In addition, Frank was a member of Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity, the Rotary, Lions and Elks Clubs in various communities as well as the home associations of the VFW and AMVETS.

Above all, Frank cherished his family. He is survived by his wife Loretta, his son Sean, daughter-in-law Michelle, and grandson Mason of Allentown, PA, his brother Bruce (Ruth) of Charleston, WV, brother-in-law Bruce (Pat) Palmer of Salisbury, MD, sister-in-law Barbara Koontz of Salisbury, and many nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his brother Ralph, sisters JoAnn Kittiner and Marilyn Stotts, and brother-in-law Calvin Palmer.

In keeping with Frank's selflessness and service to future generations, he participated in a number of research studies on Parkinson's Disease at Johns Hopkins Center for Parkinson's Disease and Movement Disorders. He made the ultimate gift to science and education by bequeathing his body to continue research in hopes of helping future Parkinson's patients.

A celebration of Frank's life will be held on March 8th, 2025 at 1:00 PM at the Chambersburg Country Club. Student Records

Alumni and Students with graduating years of 1976-2009 need to contact the DMVA. The contact person at DMVA is Kay Marks, Records Coordinator. Her number is 717-861-7713, and her email address is: kay-marks@pa.gov. Ms. Marks has your records at Ft. Indiantown Gap in Annville, PA and is very helpful and quick to turn around requests. Alumni and Students with graduating years of 1895-1975 need to request records from the PA State Archives. You may ask the State Archives representative to copy everything in your record. To release copies of files to former students and alumni, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania State Archives will need a written request from the student/alumnus, signed by the student/alumnus. Send the student/alumnus's full name, date of birth and Social Security number. Research and copy fees will apply to mail requests. The Research fee is \$15.00 for requests from Pennsylvania residents; \$25.00 for requests from out of state. The Copy fee for the first 10 pages is free; thereafter it is \$0.50 per page plus shipping and handling for additional pages. Mail your request to State Archives, PA Historical & Museum Commission, 350 North St., Harrisburg, PA 17120-0090. If the student/alumnus visits in person, the State Archives representative will need to see current identification such as a driver's license or passport. Copying fees will apply: \$0.50 per page. For inquiries, the State Archives number is: (717) 783-3281.

I salute my dear friend (1997), who was an AK1(AW) Air Warfare Specialist, Bonnie Pendleton aka Bonnie Brown, US Navy Veteran who served a total of 30 years of military Service, inclusive of 20 years of active duty & 10 years fleet reserve.

Bonnie Pendleton, you served as a Forerunner for many women and paved the way for me! A military career service woman, leader, wife, mother, grandmother, and friend!




Mike Chapman '02


